



Travel Technician

Responsibilities:

- Travel as assigned to various districts across the USIC footprint to locate, identify, and mark underground facilities
- Understand and reference records, maps, and prints to accurately locate underground facilities
- Utilize locating equipment and follow locate procedures to ensure accurate and quality locates
- Wear appropriate PPE, follow established safety practices and procedures, and address concerns as needed
- Organize and prioritize locate tickets to be completed during the workday, as directed by the supervisor
- Check company vehicle, equipment, and supplies before leaving for the first locate daily
- Ensure equipment is fully operational
- Interact with utility clients and/or contractors to coordinate locates and maintain favorable relations
- Maintain professional and positive interactions with customers and property owners
- Interact with teammates respectfully and professionally
- Positively model USIC safety expectations and standards

Qualifications:

- Must commit to position for a minimum of 6 months while being available to travel nationwide 75% of the time
- Technician with 1 year of utility locating experience required
- A quality and driver score of 10 is required
- Must have gas and telecom locating experience
- Water and sewer locating experience preferred

Required Skills:

- **Adaptability:** Having the capacity to be certain in one's abilities, competencies, and decisions
- **Accountability:** Taking responsibility for their own actions, their team's actions, and the outcomes of those actions
- **Time management:** Ability to organize and plan how to divide your time between different responsibilities
- **Work Ethic:** Belief that work and diligence have a moral benefit and strengthen character and individual abilities
- **Punctuality:** Ability to be prompt, attend obligations on time and ensure deliverable are met by the given deadline
- **Communication:** Ability effectively convey directives, processes, feedback as well as receive feedback from direct reports
- **Problem Solving:** Ability to be creative and utilize critical thinking when faced with a problem/issue
- **Stress management:** Ability to carry out job responsibilities effectively and exercise sound decision making in a chaotic environment
